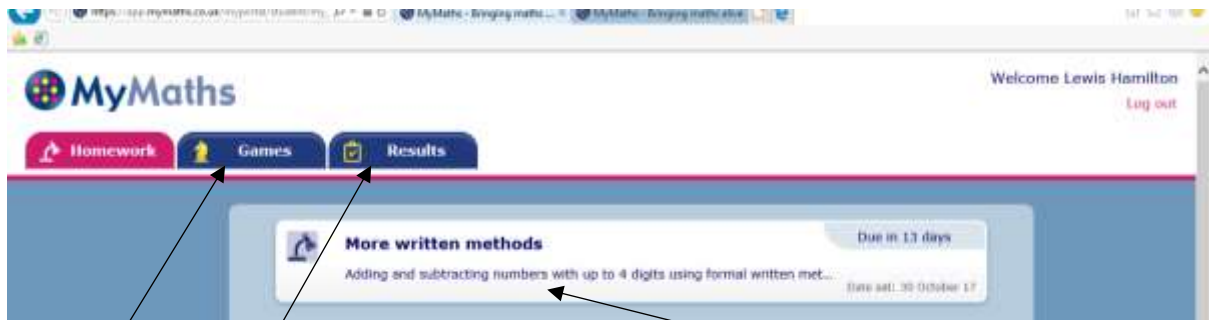

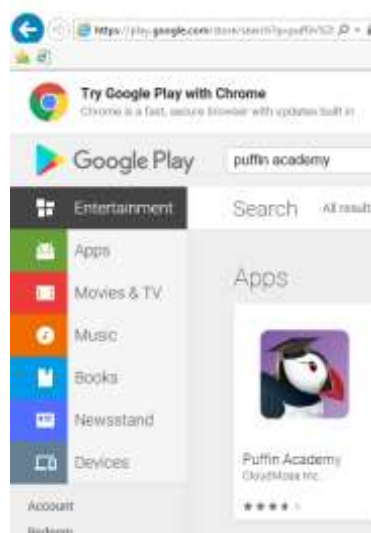


My Maths - A Rough Guide



To use My Maths on an iPad or an Android Tablet:

- 1) Download the free app Puffin Academy.



This allows Flash to work on the iPad and Android tablet.

- 2) In the Puffin Academy search bar, search for My Maths and then follow the rest of the Rough Guide to My Maths as above.

(Best used on an iPad or android tablet rather than a smart phone due to the screen size.)
