Children wearing jewellery in school: School Policy

To _____

I write to remind you, as a matter of general safety of the potential hazard involving your child/ren wearing earrings in school. Basically, it is much safer and easier if jewellery is kept for wearing out of school. Earrings represent a specific risk of causing damage by tearing the ear lobe. If your child is to continue to wear earrings, they must be restricted to the stud-type or sleeper and you must accept responsibility for any pain or injury that may occur from an accident.

Your child will be required to remove his/her earrings for PE or tape them with tape supplied from home. Please note that teachers and teaching assistants are not permitted to apply or remove tape for children.

If you are sure that you wish your child to continue to wear earrings in school, please send in appropriate tape and sign and return the form below which assures me that you understand the risks involved,
