

Year 2 Autumn Term Topic 2: Willington

In Year 2, our topic this half term is 'What would Marvin find interesting about Willington?' We will be learning about this topic for 7 weeks.

Please choose *at least one* of the following ideas, to complete at home alongside any reading and spelling investigation work that you are currently doing. At the end of the topic, your homework and models will be displayed within school.

Go on a walk around the village and take photographs of what they find.	Write a poem about the village/their favourite place there or send a postcard to someone.
Create a map of the village with a key.	Write a story about Marvin on an adventure in Willington.
Research what Willington was like in the past.	Do a traffic survey of a road in Willington and see how busy it is.
Draw/paint/make a model of their favourite part of Willington/their house.	Design a road sign for Twyford Road to encourage cars to slow down for school children.
Create a map of their route to school.	Visit https://canalrivertrust.org.uk/explorers/water-safety to learn about water safety and write a few sentences about what they have learnt.
Make a bow and arrow to investigate forces.	Investigate different designs of paper aeroplanes to see which glides through the air better.
